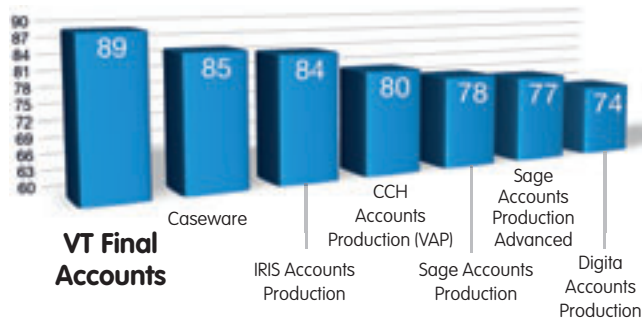
Periodically the ICAEW issues a report on the performance of software used by member firms. The *IT in accountancy practices survey report 2011\** was based on 700 telephone interviews conducted during August and September 2011 with IT decision makers in member firms and offices in the UK. Respondents were asked to give an assessment for performance, reliability, ease of use, initial service and ongoing support.

## Accounts production

In the accounts production category VT Final Accounts was used by 18% of practices and was the best performing package in each dimension (performance, reliability, ease of use, initial service and ongoing support). The aggregate scores achieved by each product were as follows (max 100):



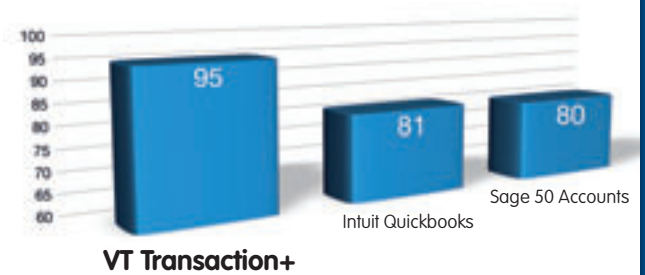

### The report concludes:

“VT Final Accounts is the standout performer across all dimensions and has pulled ahead of IRIS as the best performing package since 2007. VT has improved in overall total score and, in particular, has a 0% business critical failure rate in 2011.”

## Bookkeeping

In the bookkeeping category, VT Transaction+ was used by 8% of practices and was the best performing package in each dimension by a large margin (performance, reliability, ease of use, initial service and ongoing support). The aggregate scores achieved by each product were as follows (max 100):

“VT Transaction+ stands out as the highest performer, with strong scores across all dimensions: although a small user base, those few who use this software are particularly positive, with 100% recommendation levels.”
